College Early Start (CES) Enrollment Form High School (Grades 9 – 12) Students

Students are responsible for being aware of and adhering to all policies, procedures, and deadlines contained in the Schedule of Classes, College Catalog and Student Handbook (including Add and Drop deadlines) as they pertain to Delta College students. Students are responsible for all Delta College fees, including enrollment fees and non-resident fees. College Early Start students who are classified as California residents for tuition purposes are highly encouraged to apply for a Board of Governor's Fee Waiver. Students will receive credit for community college courses in the same manner as a regularly enrolled community college student. Granting of high school credit is solely determined by the high school district.

For counseling, financial aid and course prerequisite purposes, it is highly recommended that you submit a high school transcript.

Under Section 49061 of the California Education Code and Title 10, section 1232g (federal law) parents do not have the right of access to the student's college records, **regardless of the student's age**. No information about attendance, behavior, or grades may be released to the parent. Enrollment information, including grades, is released to the high school during the term and at the end of each term.

Admitted high school students will be interacting socially with adult college students. San Joaquin Delta College is not responsible for these social interactions. Enrolled high school students may be exposed to discussions, readings, and visual materials of a mature nature and will be expected to conform to the same performance standards as any other college student as set forth in course outlines and syllabi. San Joaquin Delta College is released from the responsibility of monitoring minor students enrolled as a College Early Start student

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL CONCURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS:

- 1. This form must be submitted and you must have an active Application for Admission on file.
- 2. Enrollment is limited to 11 or fewer units per semester.
- 3. Enrollment is limited to college-level courses.
- 4. Students are required to fulfill minimum day requirements at their high school when that school is in session. Students who exit high school during the term covered by this enrollment form must notify the Admissions & Records office. Failure to do so is a violation of the student code of conduct.
- 5. Enrollment in P.E. courses is limited; as a result <u>very few</u> high school students will be eligible to enroll in physical education courses. Please see reverse side for further information.
- 6. High school students requiring academic accommodations and/or modifications will be directed to the disabilities coordinator for services through the high school district's IDEA/504 Plan.

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES FOR COLLEGE EARLY START STUDENTS:

- 1. Identify appropriate college level courses with your high school counselor.
- 2. Submit the College Early Start Enrollment Form with all required signatures and your high school transcript, no later than 48 hours prior to registering for class/es.

Important Information Regarding Physical Education Courses

California Legislature passed legislation limiting the enrollment of high school students in physical education classes. Delta College limits the percentage of high school students to 5% in any one physical education course. As a result, **very few** high school students will be eligible to enroll in physical education courses at the College. Therefore, students should plan on enrolling in physical education classes at their high school and seek only college enrichment courses at Delta College.

Only students officially enrolled during the registration cycle **before** the term begins will be allowed to attend physical education classes. **Under no circumstances will students be permitted to register for any physical education courses once the term begins.**
