



ROOSEVELT STUDENT OF THE MONTH and PERFECT ATTENDANCE CRITERIA

Roosevelt Elementary School grades K-6 will recognize TWO Students of the Month. Grades 7th and 8th will recognize THREE Students of the Month per grade level. Two students will be nominated by their grade level teachers. One student will be nominated by their elective teachers (Art and PE).

These students emulate Roosevelt, “Creating a Culture of Excellence.”

Students chosen for this recognition must display the following characteristics....

RESPONSIBILITY

- Comes to school prepared and ready to learn.
- Uses class time wisely and completes class work in a timely manner.
- Completes homework in a timely manner.
- Follows directions and gives 100% of their best effort in class.
- They are actively engaged in their learning.
- Student follows class and school rules.

RESPECTFULNESS

- Honest, trustworthy, and respectful.
- Polite and respectful towards other students, staff, volunteers and all guests and visitors.
- Uses kind and positive words.
- Listens to the speaker (teacher or peer).
- Be respectful to themselves, each other, their school and their community.

SAFE

- Follows playground rules, game rules, class/school rules.
- Keeps hands and feet to self.
- No detentions or referrals.
- Uses objects appropriately and with care.
- Uses appropriate noise levels in hallway and cafeteria.

PERFECT ATTENDANCE CRITERIA

Regular, punctual attendance is essential to the progress and success of every student. At Roosevelt, we expect all children to have at least 98% attendance unless there are exception circumstances. Perfect attendance is celebrated each month with each child who has 100% attendance for the month receiving a certificate and a gift. At the end of the school year an attendance trip will be awarded to all pupils with 100% attendance all year.

Punctuality

At Roosevelt, we place a huge importance on punctuality and consider it vital that all children arrive at school on time. If children arrive late this not only interrupts the lesson but makes it difficult for the class teacher to settle the children. Furthermore, if your child misses the introduction of a lesson it makes it difficult for them to understand what they are learning that day. So, it is important that your child is punctual to benefit from the entire learning experience. If the child is late, he/she will not be able to get a perfect attendance certificate.
