For any individual age 8 and older who has been the victim of a crime and has registered an application with the California Victim Assistance Program: individual therapy, provided that the individual's private insurance has denied treatment.

An emergency shelter for homeless or runaway youth ages 12–17 or youth at risk of becoming homeless.
