3 ways to get to a Safe Place

1. Text the word "safe" and your current street name, city, and state to: 69866.
2. Board any San Joaquin RTD bus and ask for Safe Place.
3. Go to any McDonald's in San Joaquin County and ask the cashier to connect you with Safe Place.

THERAPY SERVICES

Our therapists are trained to treat a wide variety of mental-health conditions in adults and children, such as, but not limited to, depression, anxiety, and trauma. We offer the following services:

For youth ages 8-20 who have full-scope Medi-Cal insurance:
individual and family therapy.

For any individual age 8 and older who has been the victim of a crime and has registered an application with the California Victim Assistance Program: individual therapy, provided that the individual's private insurance has denied treatment.

Safe House

An emergency shelter for homeless or runaway youth ages 12-17 or youth at risk of becoming homeless. We can provide up to 21 days of emergency shelter as well as food, clothing, crisis assessment, therapy, case management, educational support, referrals and aftercare. 24-hour youth helpline (209) 948-1911.



Opportunity House

A homeless shelter for emancipated youth 16-17 or youth 18-21 years old. You can stay in this shelter for up to 21 months and receive case management, life skills training, therapy, and other supportive services to assist you in becoming independent. Contact us at (209) 929-6735 for more details.

- Individual and family therapy
- Mediation between individuals
