Once placement is completed, there will be no changes to schedules. Our program is extremely impacted, and we will do our best to accommodate all requests. There are required Summer Readings, and Math Assignments. All assignments for all grade levels are posted on our website by May 1st. \_\_\_\_\_ There is a community service requirement for all students. If student does not continue with the MYP, he or she will return to their home school. Acceptance into the IB Program and continued placement in the program is contingent upon good attendance, acceptable behavior, and continued good academic standing as outlined in the parent student agreement. Students must meet the 20 credits PE State requirement, in order to graduate, at the 9<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> grade levels. Due to the high academic demands of the IB Program, students may have to complete their PE credits outside of school hours. Possible options are as follows: 1. Play a sport (football, soccer, volleyball, track and field, badminton, etc.) 2. Join a gym and participate in an organized gym class (Zumba, Body Pump, Yoga etc.) 3.
