- 2019 tax information (1040s and W2s)
- Driver's License, if you have one
- Social Security Card, if you have one
- Alien Registration Card, if you have one
- ITIN (Individual Taxpayer Identification Number), if you have one
- List of Colleges you are interested in
- Most current bank statements
- Any records of untaxed income such as child support, social security or welfare benefits
