

Dress Code

ONLY COLLARED SHIRTS:

- Solid Colors: Black, White, or Gray
- Shirts must be tucked in
- · Layers are permitted if in uniform colors
- No bare midriffs

PANTS/SKIRT:

- Solid Colors: Khaki/Beige or black (NO LOGOS)
