### To register for the GED test at Stockton School for Adults:

1. Log into [www.ged.com](http://www.ged.com)
2. Click on My GED and create an account using your e-mail.
3. Once your account has been set up, click on the "Schedule Test." You can select School for Adults as your testing site.

**Identification:** Your name must exactly match your identification that is presented at the test center. If your name does not match you will not be able to sit for your exam and you will not receive a refund. To change your name, contact Pearson VUE at 1-877-392-6433, Monday - Friday, 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, CST.

**Age Requirements:** You must be 18 years of age or older or within 60 days of your 18th birthday. If you are within 60 days of when you would have graduated from high school had you remained in school and followed the usual course of study. Candidates testing under this criteria may **not** be enrolled in school. You are 17 years of age, have been out of school for at least 60 consecutive days, and provide a letter of request for the test from the military, a postsecondary educational institution, or a prospective employer. *Important note:* If you pass the GED® test at age 17 you will not receive the equivalency certificate until your 18th birthday; a letter of intent is issued and states that the certificate is being held pending the examinee's 18th birthday.

**On the day of the test:** Do not bring any personal items (i.e. purse, cell phone, pager, tote bag, portable music players, hand-held electronic games, food or drink items, textbooks, dictionaries, notebooks, unauthorized computer aid, supplies, scratch paper, jackets, coats and hats). Any items brought into the testing center will need to be stored in the locker provided to you. We shall not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.

**Test Scores:** California test-takers need to score a 145 on each subject area test in order to pass.

•Below Passing: 100-144 •GED Passing Score: 145-164 •GED College Ready: 165-174 •GED College Ready + Credit: 175-200

**Retest Information:** GED Testing Service allows individuals to take the test three times without any waiting period. After the third attempt, test-takers must wait 60-days after their last attempt before they can test again. This will result in test-takers having up to eight opportunities to test in a year, should they require that many attempts.

**Retest Fees:** The price of the retest varies based on where you retest.
