We want to ensure that seniors and their families are aware of all senior related requirements and activities. Graduation Requirements

The class of 2024 must earn 210 credits and pass specific subject requirements in order to earn a high school diploma. If students violate school rules, they may be prohibited from taking part in the graduation ceremony and/or school activities. They would also be required to attend extended year in June, in order to earn their high school diploma.




