California Math Corps

Math Corps is an evidence-based math intervention program that places AmeriCorps Members as tutors into elementary and middle schools. Members work with pairs of students to support the development of foundational skills in working with numbers and their operations with a focus on algebra readiness.

JOB TITLE: Math Enrichment Tutor

POSITION SUMMARY

The Math Enrichment Tutor works with pairs of students (4th - 8th grade) who are not proficient in math. The Math Enrichment Tutor implements prescribed mathematics interventions and strategies and conducts progress monitoring assessments to ensure students are on track to reach proficiency.

Tutors serve at one school from January – June 2020. Regular, timely attendance during school hours is required. Tutors serve 3-5 days per week, between 20-35 hours. This is an AmeriCorps service member position with the California Math Corps program. Position starts January 13th, 2020.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be 18 years of age or older by your start date.
- Must have at least a high school diploma or recognized equivalent by your start date.
- Must be either a citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident alien of the United States.
- Must pass mandatory pre-service background checks.
- Must not have served 4 or more prior terms of service with AmeriCorps State or National.
- Speak, read, and write English fluently.
- Interest in education, specifically helping students improve their math skills.
- Dedication to community service.
- Basic computer skills, including the ability to navigate online systems and email.
- Energetic, results-oriented, student-focused style.
- Strong planning and time-management skills.
- Strong capacity to be flexible and adaptable to varied circumstances, paired with a conscientious commitment to adhere to the Math Corps tutoring model with fidelity.
- Consistent follow-through.
- Ability to accept and incorporate constructive feedback from coaches and program staff.
- Ability to work with diverse populations.
- Ability to adapt to a sometimes challenging and high-pressure environment.
- Strong personal standards of excellence, ethics, and integrity.







COMPENSATION/BENEFITS

Benefits include a living allowance of between \$400-\$560, an education award of up to \$2300 that can be used to repay student loans or future education expenses; student loans may be deferred.

SALARY

Living allowance of \$400-\$560 every two weeks, before taxes

SCHEDULE / HOURS:

Monday - Friday, 20-35 hours/week. Requires 3-5 days per week; after-school hours may be required. Position starts January 13th, 2020 and ends June 20th, 2020.
