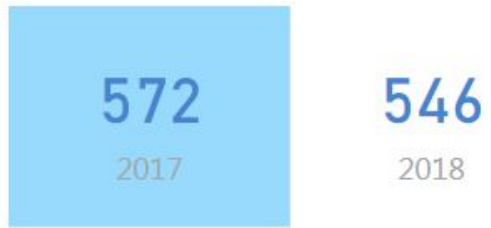

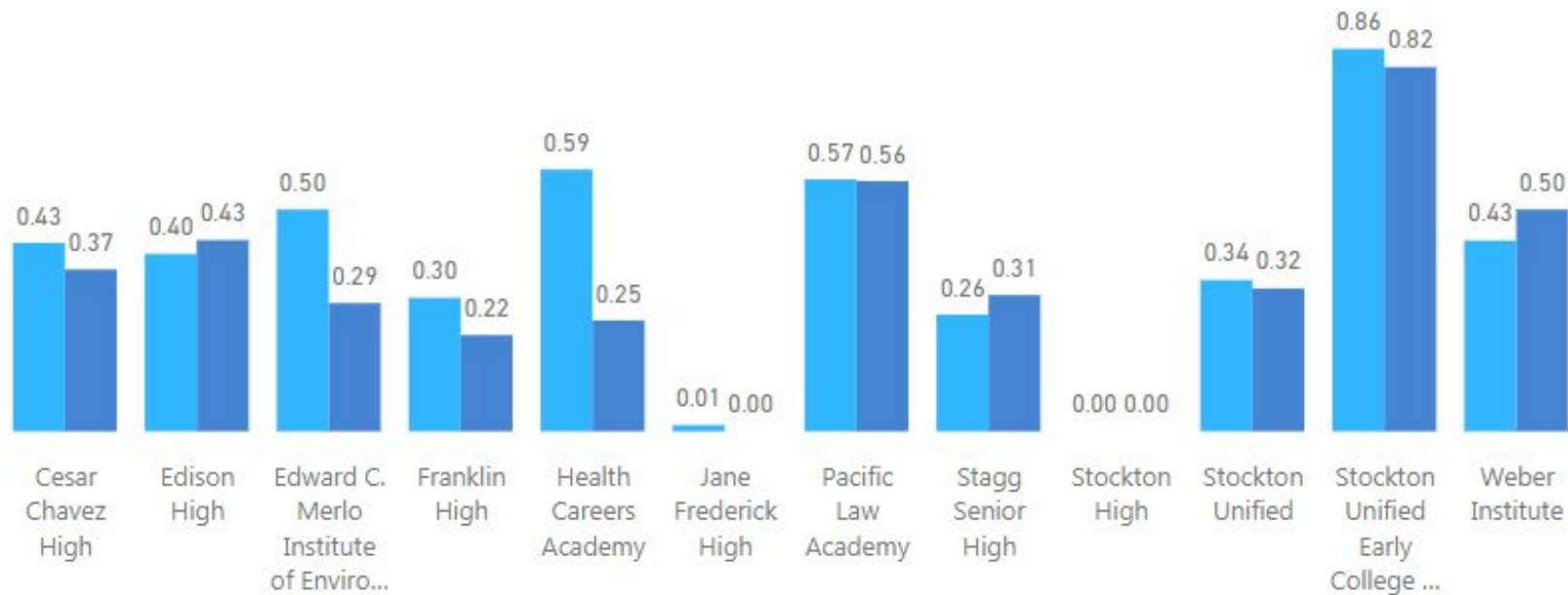

### Count of AP Course Passed

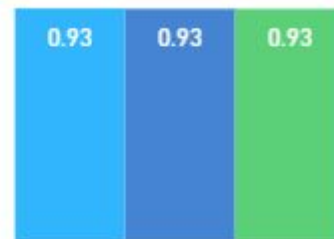


### Count of AP Course Taken

### Count of AP Exams Passed

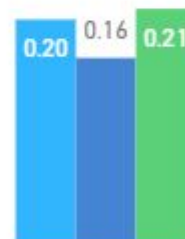


### Count of AP Exams Taken

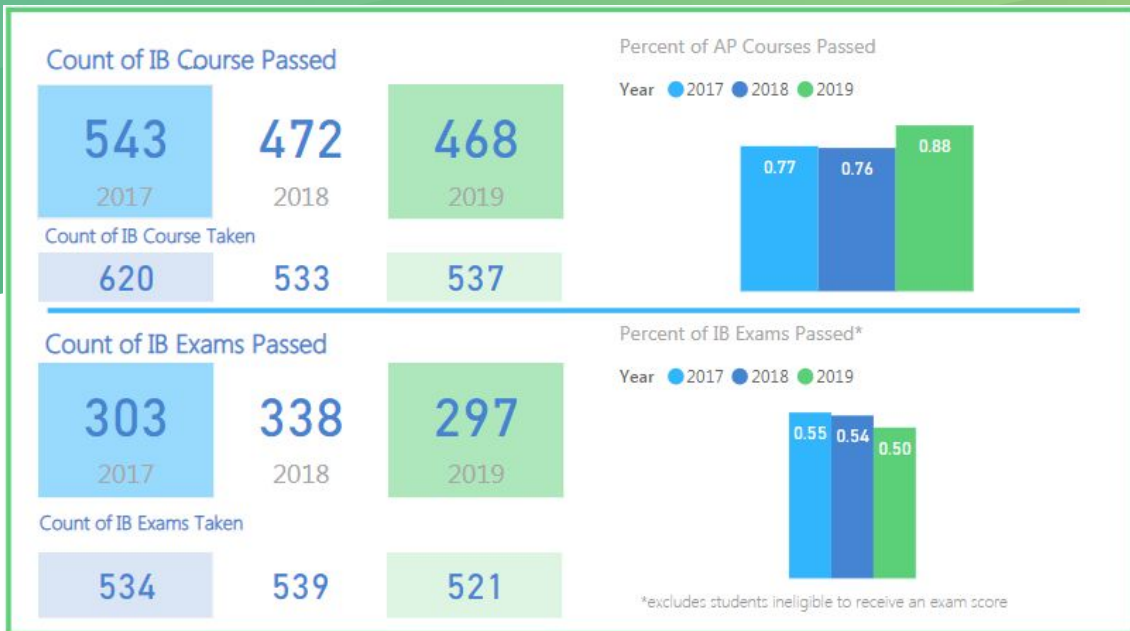

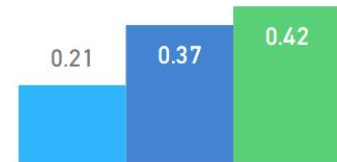

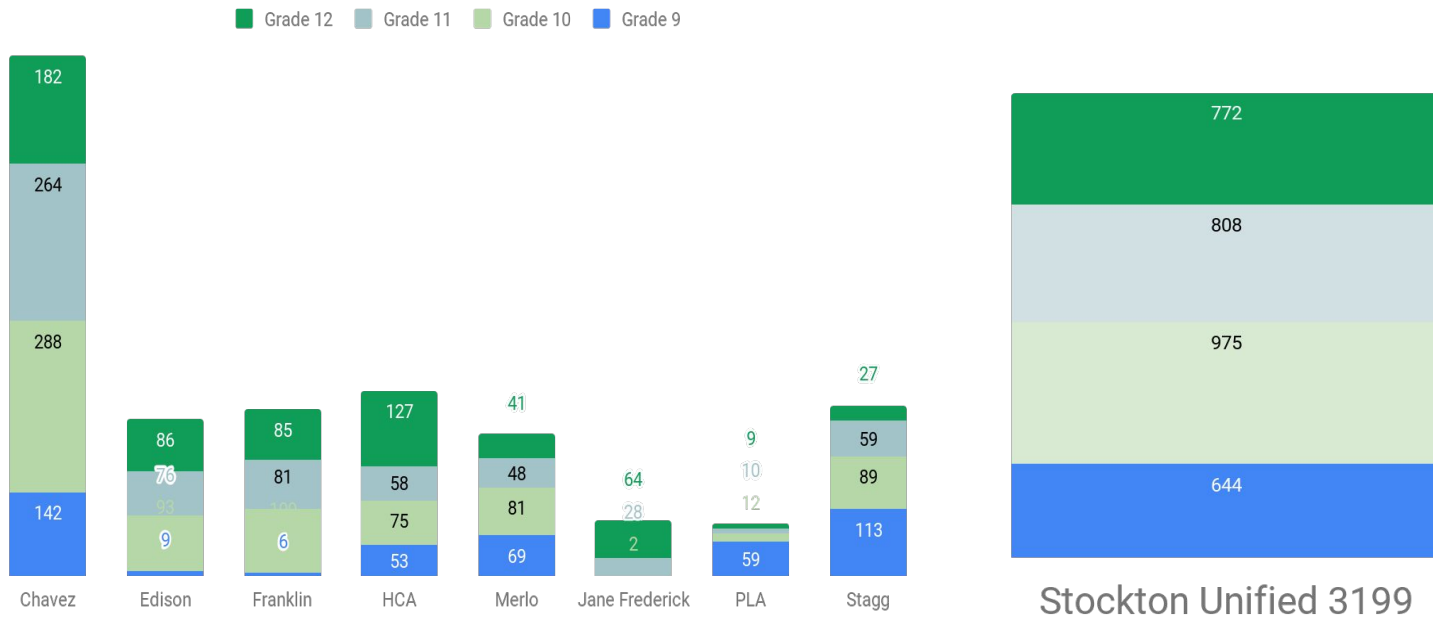

Teachers: Years of Experience



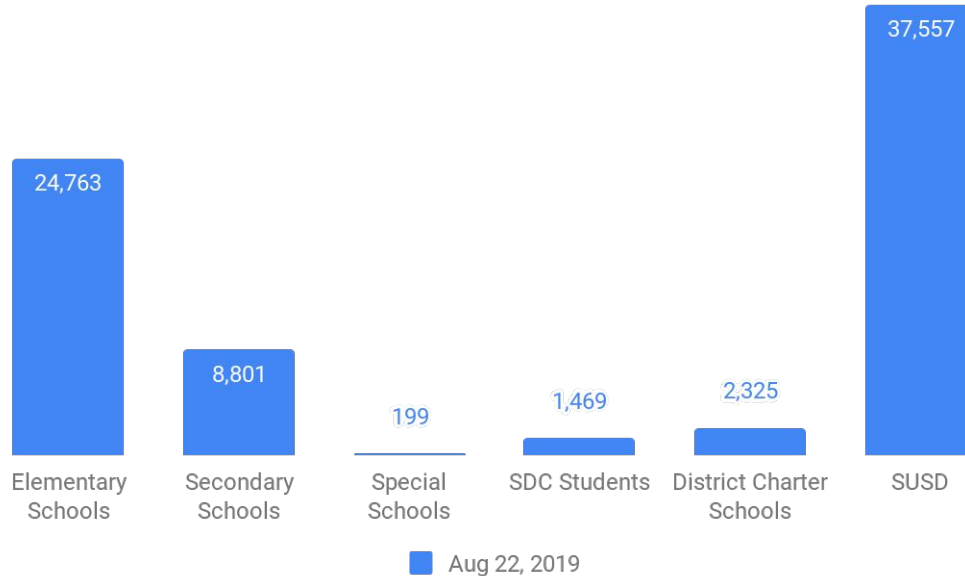

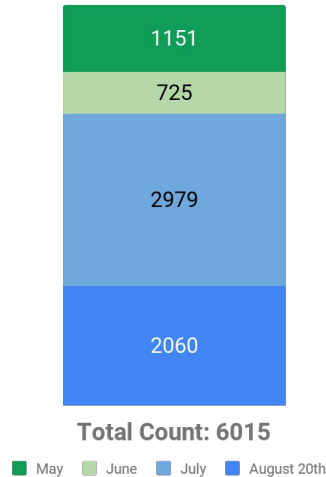

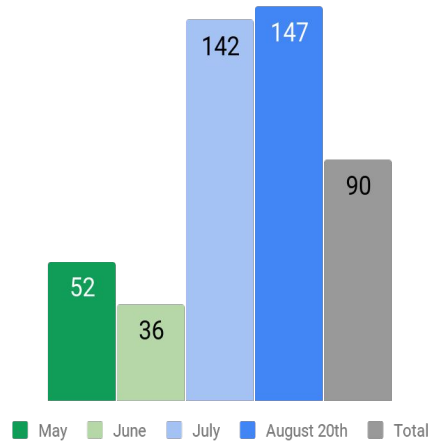

Average Count of Families Served (daily)



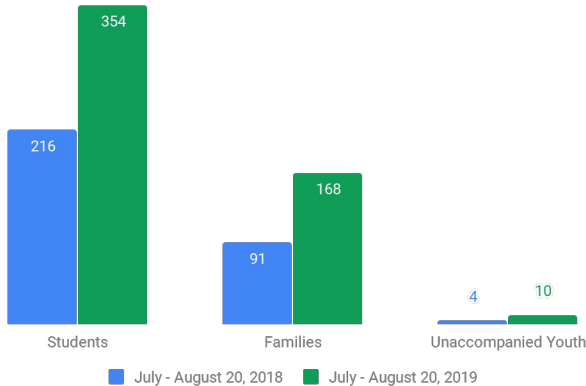

# Families In Transition & Foster Youth

## Types of Services:

- Information about the McKinney Vento Federal Protection Laws/Rights
- Community Resources: Food Bank, Shelters, Central Valley Housing, Second Harvest food bank distribution list, etc...
- Provide backpacks/supplies/uniforms if at a uniform school/hygiene/snacks/ etc...
- Request transportation if needed (K-6<sup>th</sup> grade)
- Inform student or parent regarding no cost RTD transportation (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade)
- Provide referrals to after school program for priority acceptance if requested
- If needed, provide waivers for: CA I.D., Birth Certificate
- Provide Medi-Cal application if needed and assist with filling out application
- Referrals to community agencies
- Provide AB1806 qualifications information to students
- Assist with Post-secondary goals
- Provide FAFSA Verification for Unaccompanied Youth
