To King School Parents and Guardians,

We are welcoming all students back to campus on August 2, 2021. School begins at **7:30 a.m.** and there is a staggered dismissal. After an unprecedented year of mostly Distance Learning, we are so excited to have all of our students back together. There will be some adjustments and maybe even some anxieties about coming back in person, but rest assured we are ready and prepared to welcome your children back to in person learning.

At this time, we will keep in place our drop off locations in the mornings the same as in May. There will be 4 drop off locations. You will need to drop off your children according to location of classroom. To reduce the amount of on campus foot traffic, parents will not be allowed to enter through the gates in the mornings or for pick up. Teachers and support staff will be outside waiting for students when the gates open between 7:15 and 7:20. **Students are required to wear masks indoors per the CDC health guidelines.** 

All students eating breakfast on campus will enter through the front gates and go directly to the cafeteria. Breakfast is served 7:00-7:25 a.m.

Dismissal times are as follows:

1:25 p.m. for Grades TK, K, and 1 1:30 p.m. for Academy 1, 2, and 3 (Grades 2-6) 1:35 for Middle School (Grades 7 and 8)

Additional ways to ensure a successful year include:

- Come to school on time and daily. Every day counts!
- Chromebooks for grades 2-8 will need to be brought back and forth daily until we restore our 1:1 ratio.
- Come to school prepared. Backpacks, AVID binders or organizational folders, and supplies help your child be ready for learning.
- King school continues to adhere to the SUSD Dress and Conduct codes. Students in primary grades are welcome to wear school uniforms. Intermediate students are asked to wear school ready attire. This is addressed in your first day packets if you need clarification.
- Fill out all forms sent home the first week especially the emergency cards. We need current phone numbers!
