Hello Madison Families,

Back to School Night is here, and we are working hard to manage our new normal. We want to develop a safe program that addresses all student needs. Our focus this year is teaching K-3rd students to read/comprehend proficiently, and teaching all students to think, question, process, and apply their skills to a relevant context. We want them to build their capacity to apply all concepts they are taught. Learning to think is a back and forth process of connecting prior knowledge and using it in new and relevant situations. They need to know how they learn and how true learning theoretically happens. Our site focus this year is in three areas: relationships/building our communities' collective efficacy and belief in the impossible. Secondly, student empowerment will include character traits, restorative circles, integrating social emotional skills, Maslow's self-awareness, student led-conferences, and understanding what drives your will and skill. We want to turn learning loss into learning leaps, and finally teaching them how to think and not what to think!

Our new safety norms for our public health crisis are the following: Mandatory masking indoors at all times! You can remove your mask in the cafeteria when eating and drinking.
