Hello Madison Families,

Happy 2022 New Year! We are encouraging perfect attendance by adhering to safety protocols, dressing warm and being responsive to the weather conditions. Protecting yourself by immunizing well with vitamin c/healthy soups/fruit/vegetables and eating habits. Thank you again for your honest feedback and all the adjustments you make to help your students improve. We are now focused on future proofing our school and conducting a needs assessment as the next major task. In terms of skill, we are asking for 20 minutes of reading, 40 minutes of iReady, and 20 minute of Flocabulary. We will be meeting with 8th-graders who are below a 6th-grade level for intense intervention and tutoring. In terms of building student will and character, we are working to build agency. Agency is a powerful educational buzzword that focuses on all the components of learning management – belief in self, knowledge of how you learn/think/make decisions, and knowledge of self-interest. We essentially have five months left to usher in the best thinking and most powerful mindsets. Our sense of urgency is making sure your self-talk and personal narratives are positive. We want our Mustangs bold enough to self-advocate and ask questions, and courageous enough to share ideas. These two elements of self-regulation and metacognition fuel learning. The way they think and their thinking about their thinking – metacognition need to be developed well. We need to make sure they have the right influencers and influences in their lives! Our new initiatives for the final 90 days will include a simple but high leverage instructional focus. AVID for 8th-6th grade, on-demand writing and close/volume reading, and RTI Math. We are incredibly proud of the perseverance, resilience, grit and agency made visible in the face of the various challenges.
