Welcome back, Madison Families!

We are inviting you to continue to build with us in the 2022-2023 school year as our mantra/slogan hones in on a focus on the WINS and the positives to boost student learning. As we continue to work through new challenges each year and survive with grace and clear learning outcomes, it is apparent that deep roots are beginning to strengthen our character, connection, and commitments to student success. Our six-year story of success has largely been attributed to your support and feedback. You play a huge role in teaching us how to teach your children. No roadblocks have interfered with our goal to truly build an instructional program that inspires lifelong learning – goal setting, applying appropriate skills/knowledge, self-direction, ability to locate required information, and adapt their learning to strategies to different conditions. Children's learning styles and needs are as unique as their DNAs, and we need to work together to personalize them for meaningful and empowering outcomes. Enduring construction and history making appears to be our most pressing challenge as we prepare for a new construction shift in 52 days - we are scheduled to move into the new building. We want to develop a safe plan that addresses all student needs during phase 2 construction, 6th-8th will be utilizing the Madison Park for outdoor PE, the cafeteria will be used as a gymnasium 3 days a week, and school walks will be scheduled. Trimester 1 is a focus on reading and comprehension. Studies show that 52 hours on one concentrated subject will increase a student's progress by one grade level. Please help create a routine at home for independent reading, iReady, and math fluency 30 minutes each per day. K-3rd should read one book a week and should engage in 3 reads – read to self, read aloud, and read with a partner. Grades 4th-8th should read two novels a month. Trimester 2 will focus on writing and RTI math. All site communication will be sent via Madison website at stocktonusd.net/Madison.
