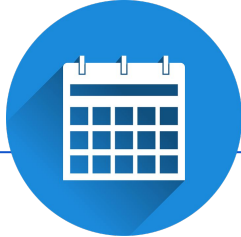

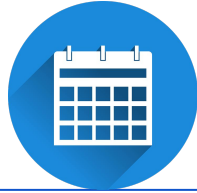

Transportation



Start and dismissal times were submitted to Transportation

- **Bus services will be provided to those who live 1 mile or more from El Dorado**

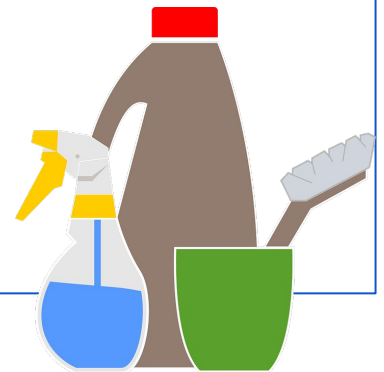
Information was submitted to Transportation Services & Special Education identifying A/B groups for all SDC students requiring transportation

- **Only students with specific curb to curb transportation will be accommodated**
- **Transportation will be contacting parents with schedule for pick up and drop off**

Cleaning

- 7th/8th grade student desks to be wiped down by students upon arrival to each class.
- Teachers have been given a black crate labeled with their name. Each crate contains a roll of paper towels, a spray bottle of disinfectant, extra masks and gloves, and tech wipes for cleaning chromebooks and tech equipment when needed.
- Additional crates with supplies have been placed in teacher's lounge, work room 55, and Health Screening (Room 16)
- Rooms sanitized daily after school

Deep cleaning happens each Wednesday (and possibly every Saturday)



Restroom Usage



Restroom breaks will be escort only from classrooms or during scheduled whole class breaks

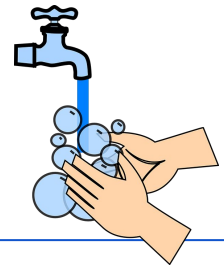
- Teachers will contact the office for an escort
- Noon Duty Supervisors/CSA will be contacted by office
- Admin, TCA, or other available staff may help as needed

Food Services/Water



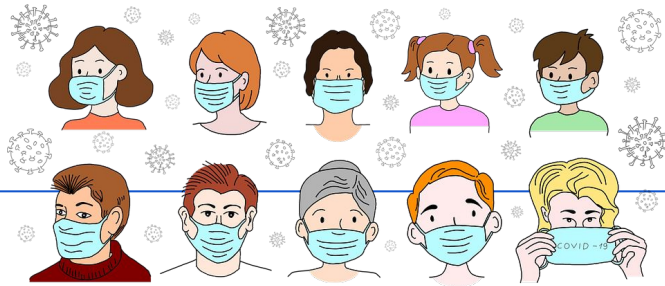
- Students who attend in person instruction will receive a grab and go lunch for that day, which will include a breakfast for the next morning and a snack
 - Students will pick up their lunch right before dismissal.
 - We will have staggered pick up times starting with TK - 2nd grade
 - Schedule to follow
- Food Services will continue the weekly food distribution times on Wednesdays
- Students who attend in person learning will receive a SUSD reusable water bottle
- Students may bring their own water bottle from home.
 - Additional disposable water bottles will be available in the classrooms as needed
 - All water fountains have been disabled per CDC guidelines

Safety



All students and staff are required to wear a mask, complete the daily health screening, and wash their hands frequently

- Handwashing stations or sinks are located in each classroom
- Students must remain 3ft from each other and 6 ft from teacher
- A medical note is required if alternative PPE options are needed



Testing and Positive Cases

If there are any positive cases confirmed, those who may have been exposed will be notified, as well those who have not been exposed.

- If a positive case is confirmed, a variety of outcomes may be possible

There are reminders about masks and social distancing, as well as directions

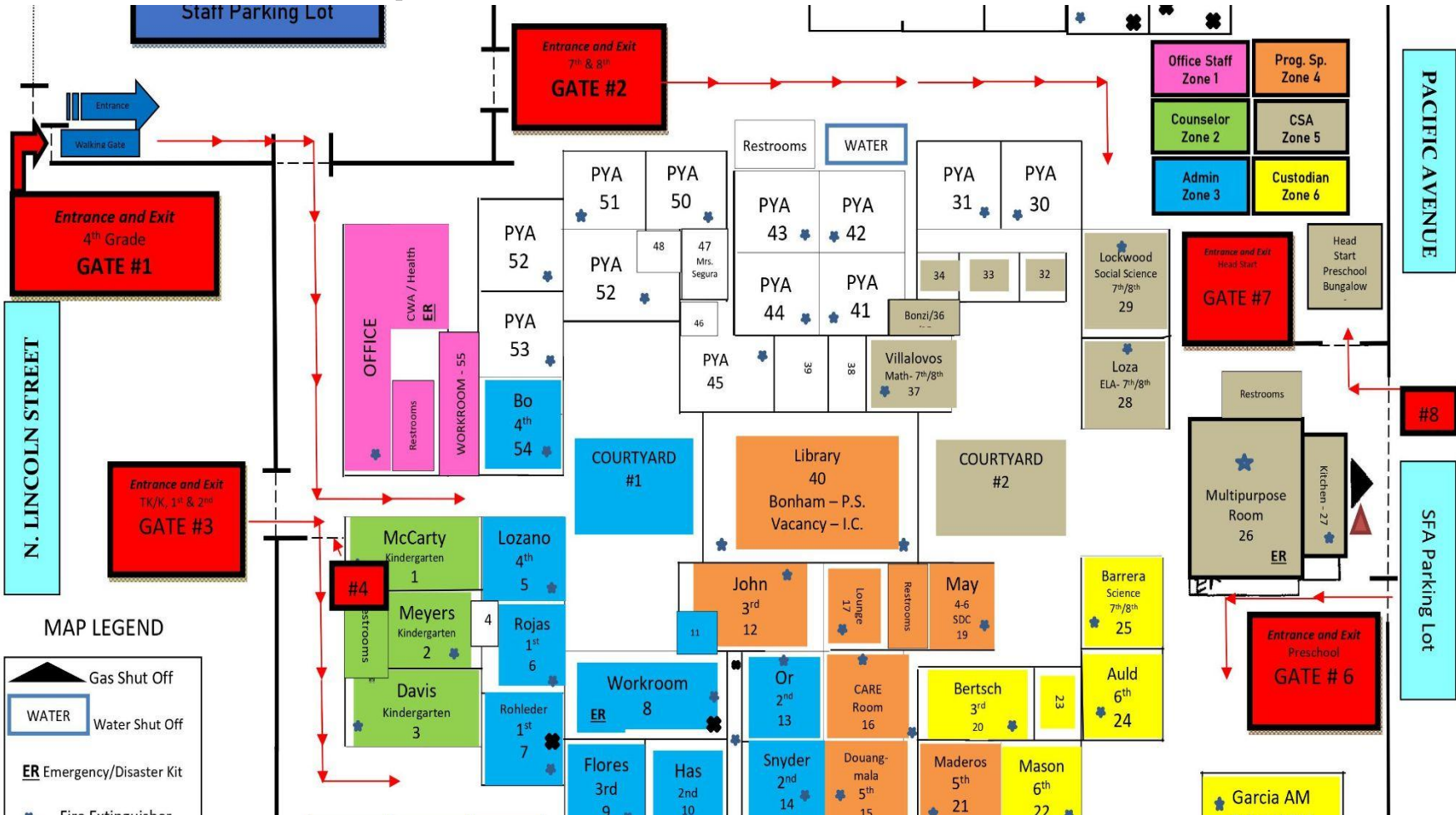
All hallways are one way only and are marked appropriately

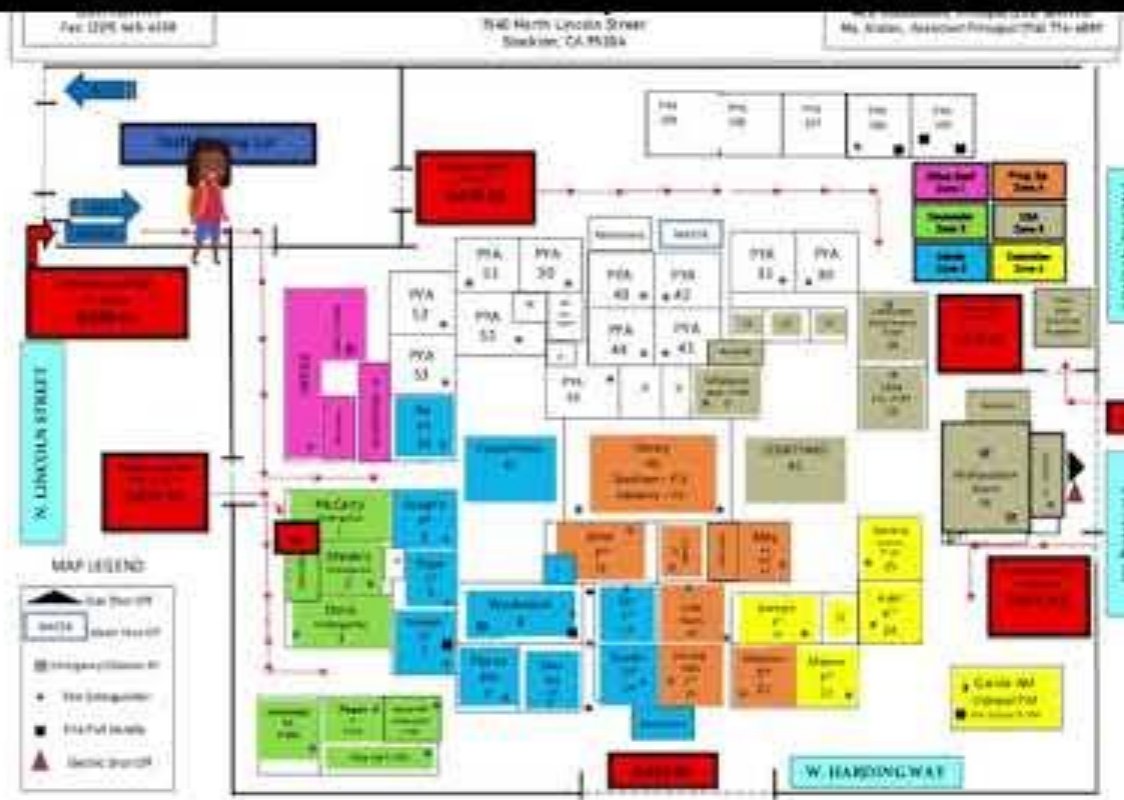

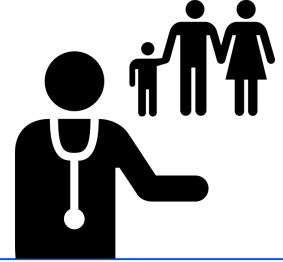


El Dorado School Map - Gate Locations





Health Screening



Students and Staff are to complete the health screening questions daily.

- **Parents/Students can go to www.stocktonusd.net/screening**
 - **The Health Clerk follows up with students who are present and have not completed the daily screener**
- **If a student feels ill, the teacher will contact the admin/CSA or call the office for an escort to a health screening room**

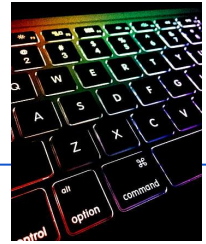

Materials and Supplies



- **Students are encouraged to bring a backpack**
 - **Students must bring their fully charged chromebooks**
 - **If a student forgets their chromebook, they will check one out from their teacher in the classroom and return it at the end of the day**
- **Students can bring their own water bottle and snack**
 - **Students who do not have a water bottle or snack will be provided with one.**
- **Students will be issued school supplies for individual use at school**
 - **Students should not share materials and materials provided will be kept at school**
 - **TK-2nd Grade students will be given pencil boxes with supplies**
 - **3rd - 8th grade will be given pencil pouches with supplies**
 - **If students need supplies for home, we will put together a separate bag of supplies - TK - 3rd grade were given small white boards for student use at home**

- **Social-Emotional Learning (SEL)**

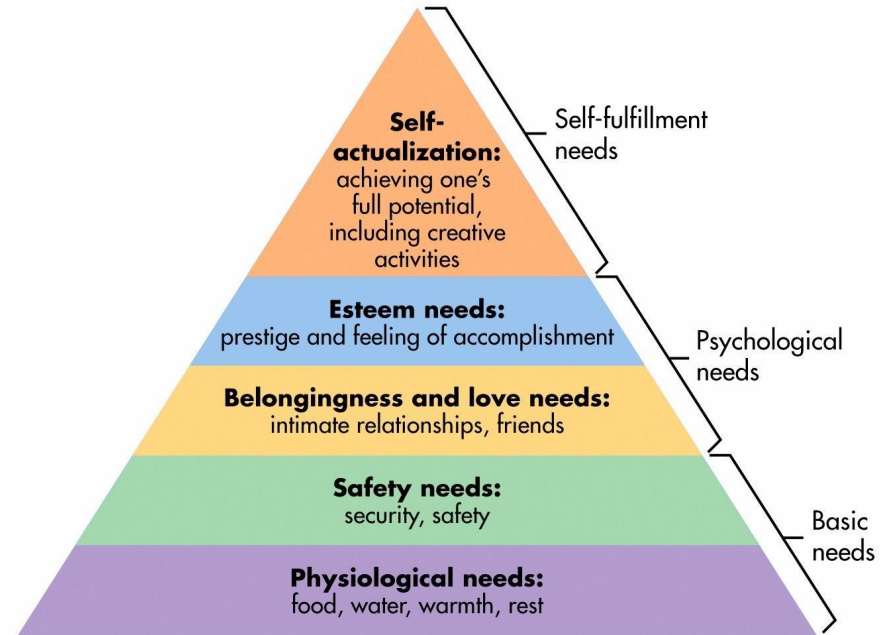


The teachers, counselors and admin have been preparing to return for months!
