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## Entering the campus:

We are limiting the number of people on our school campuses, so only students will be allowed through the gates.

Gates open at 9:00 am and students will go directly into their classrooms for class to begin at 9:05 am. Each grade level has been assigned to a specific gate for entry and dismissal. There are signs posted at each gate to indicate the number.

- Preschool and Head Start- Gate 6 (accessed through Gate 8 at the back of the cafeteria)
- Transitional Kinder/Kindergarten Gate 3, then through Gate 4
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade Gate 3, then through Gate 4
- 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Gate 5 (on Harding Way)
- 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Gate 1, then through Gate 2

## Screenings:

• Prior to coming on campus each day, families will be asked to pre-screen students for COVID symptoms.

#### Safety Protocols:

- We will be following strict guidelines for safety protocols.
  - Masks must be worn at all times
  - Students and staff will maintain 6ft of social distancing
  - Class sizes will be limited to 10-12 (varies due to class sizes) people per classroom
  - Regular hand washing will be part of our normal routine
  - Students can bring their own water bottles

#### Student Meals:

- Weekly student meals (breakfast and lunch) will be available on Wednesday's.
- Students can pick up a grab and go meal when they are on campus for their scheduled day.

#### Student dismissal:

- At the assigned dismissal time, teachers will walk students out to their assigned gate and dismiss them to their parents. Reminder that Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten are dismissed at 12:20 pm and must be picked up and cannot remain on campus.
- Parents waiting to pick up children should also be maintaining social distancing and wearing masks.
- Students will then go home, have lunch and "recess" and then work on assignments and online learning systems as directed by their teachers.
